Administrative Arrangements - Teams to comprise of Four players; Two men and Two Women as indicated in the format (below). The entrance fee is US \$ 2000/ per team this will cover two rooms per team on twin sharing basis. The fee will cover the expense on full hospitality including full board and lodge, sight- seeing arrangements, airport pickup & drop, on court refreshments etc. Spouses are welcome to join but there would be an extra charge of USD 150/- per day for covering their full expenses. The same will apply for an additional player joining the team, teams may bring an additional player, but the fee of US \$ 150 per day (twin sharing) or \$ 750 per the whole event should be paid.

The Centenary Clubs desirous of participating in this prestigious event must confirm their entry by January 1, 2013 along with their remittance of the entry fee.
